Client Need

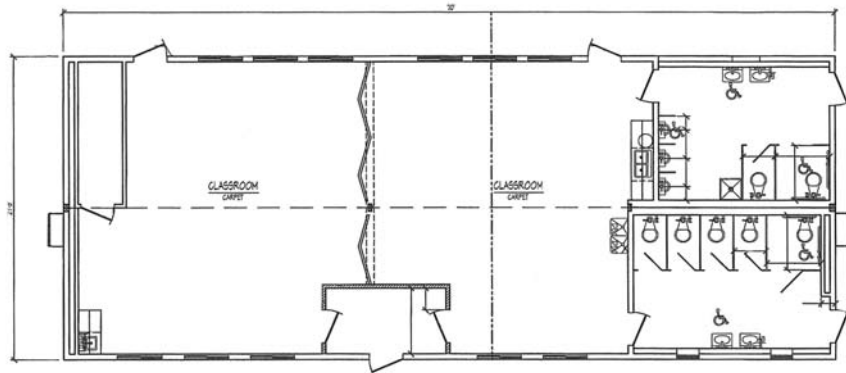

The Williams Scotsman Solution

Originally on a fast track for completion in the fall of 2009, the project was delayed several months due to unanticipated code reviews, countless modifications to the agreed upon design and materials, as well as inclement weather. Despite all these challenges, Williams Scotsman consistently met the client's needs in a timely and professional manner to deliver the project within budget and in line with the constantly shifting schedule and milestones.

The Result

Over 6,000 square feet of portable modular classroom space was created with 70'x15' composite decks to allow for outdoor dining, event observation, and expanded classroom environments. Williams Scotsman provided multi-use buildings – classrooms, school assembly rooms, public sporting event observation centers – that incorporated environmentally-friendly design elements to enhance the space. The buildings' interior features include warm tones, ample windows, and vaulted ceilings with clear story windows to create openness and complement the schools focus on the environment and outdoor learning.
